

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA COUNTY COUNCIL FOR RICHLAND COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. _____22HR

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RICHLAND COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION; ARTICLE II, COUNTY COUNCIL; SECTION 2-14, COMPENSATION OF COUNCIL MEMBERS; SO AS TO REFLECT THE NEW ANNUAL SALARY FOR COUNTY COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the authority granted by the Constitution and the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL FOR RICHLAND COUNTY:

<u>SECTION I.</u> The Richland County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Administration; Article II, County Council; Section 2-14, Compensation of council members; is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-14. Compensation of council members.

The compensation of members of the county council shall be <u>equal to 80% of the</u> <u>minimum annual salary of an employee of Richard County Government</u>. The chair of the county council shall, during his/her term as chair, receive in addition to his/her annual compensation, the sum of 10% of the annual compensation, to compensate for the additional duties required by such position. No change in the compensation of the chair and members of county council shall be effective until the date of commencement of the terms of the chair and members of council elected at the general election following the changes.

<u>SECTION II.</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any section, subsection, or clause of this ordinance shall be deemed to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, and clauses shall not be affected thereby.

<u>SECTION III.</u> <u>Conflicting Ordinances Repealed.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
