**New Business** – There was no new business offered.



→ Aircraft complaints: There were two (2) aircraft complaint during the period of Jul 1 – Aug 31, 2015. Jul – 1 / Aug – 1 Sun - 1 / Tue - 1
There were no (0) identification / Information letters sent (00%).

There was one (1) aircraft complaint during the same period in 2014.

→ Facilities & Grounds maintenance requests:

There were 23 maintenance requests during the period of Jul 1 – Aug 31, 2015.

Terminal – 35% / Airside – 57% / Landside – 8% Hangar related – 48% / Electrical related – 30%

There were 15 Facilities & Grounds maintenance requests during the same period in 2014.

## CoC Stormwater Fees



- Recent audit by CoC Stormwater Staff
- Previous monthly rate \$3,950.80
- Proposed monthly rate \$4,902.80
- Proposed Annual Fee of \$58,833 (23.5% of annual revenue)
- Seek to amend Section 23-206 (c) which provides exemptions for public roads and railroads, but does not address airport runways, taxiways, or taxilanes
- Revised monthly rate \$3,039.60
- Monthly savings of \$911.20
