New Business – There was no new business offered.


Adjournment – The meeting adjourned at 1:19 p.m.

→ Aircraft complaints: There were Six (6) aircraft complaint during the period of Sep 1 – Oct 31, 2015.

There were Two (2) identification / Information letters sent (33%). There were Five (5) aircraft complaint during the same period in 2014.

→ Facilities & Grounds maintenance requests: There were 21 maintenance requests during the period of Sep 1 – Oct 31, 2015.

Terminal – 33% / Airside – 62% / Landside – 5% Hangar related – 52% / Electrical related – 38% There were 20 Facilities & Grounds maintenance requests during the same period in 2014.
