Richland County Airport Commission Jim Hamilton – LB Owens Airport (CUB) Columbia, South Carolina

<u>Call to Order and Welcome</u> – (Acting) Chairman Dean called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. and announced a quorum in attendance. The invocation was delivered by Commissioner Hope.

Mr Eversmann introduced the two newly-appointed members of the Airport Commission:

(Acting) Chairman Dean welcomed everyone and guest introductions followed.

<u>Report of Items for Executive Session</u> – **Mr Eversmann** reported that there were no items for discussion in executive session.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u> – (Acting) Chairman Dean presented the agenda as distributed. Commissioner Kelly made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Commissioner McCreary seconded the motion, and all voted for approval.

<u>Report of Nominating Committee / Election of 2017 Officers</u> – (Acting) Chairman Dean reported out the slate of nominees for Officer positions in the upcoming calendar year (CY):

Stuart Hope – Chairman
Joel McCreary – Vice Chairman
Cecil Hannibal – Secretary
Tally Casey – Treasurer

A call for any additional nominations from the floor was made, but no additional nominations were offered. **Commissioner Kelly** moved for election of the slate by universal acclimation. **Commissioner Smith** seconded the motion and all approved. **Chairman Hope** assumed the position of Chairman and presided over the remainder of the meeting.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u> – Chairman Hope presented the minutes of the November 14, 2016 Airport Commission meeting for approval. Commissioner McCreary made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, Commissioner Casey seconded the motion, and all voted for approval.

<u>Chairman's Report / Executive Committee Report</u> – Chairman Hope did not have a report to offer due to his recent election to the post of Chairman.

Committee Reports

<u>Economic Development Committee</u> – Commissioner Dean provided a brief update on the initiative with the Richland School District One and the Heyward Career Center. He also briefed on a recommendation from the Committee on the enhancement of landscaping along the perimeter fence on Jim Hamilton Blvd. A rough order of magnitude project budget of \$42,000 was offered for information / planning purposes. A motion was made to proceed with continued planning and identifying project partners (City of Columbia Forestry Division, and the Gills Creek Watershed Association as examples), was seconded and passed unanimously.

<u>Operations & Facilities Committee</u> – Chairman Hope briefed the Commission on the status of the Airport Hangar Tenant Lease document. It is currently under review by Assistant County Attorney, Brad Farrar, who will then send his recommendations to Richland County Council. He also briefed on the most recent update for the Airport Capital Improvement Plan (ACIP) which is contained in enclosure (1) to these meeting minutes.

<u>Airport Director's Report</u> – A copy of **Mr Eversmann** PowerPoint presentation is contained in enclosure (2).

<u>County Liaison's Report</u> – Councilman Pearce addressed the issue of personal property tax rates on aircraft in the event that the issue came up for discussion in the course of the upcoming SCAA Legislative Breakfast with State House officials. Because of inadequate funding by the General Assembly of State Aid to Subdivisions, Richland County has had to pay for growth over the last several years using General Fund Balance. This has depleted the balance in the County's "Rainy Day Fund" and removes the County's flexibility to consider lowering the aircraft personal property tax rate (10.5%) to one of the available lower rate options (6% or 4%) and the accompanying, short-term loss of revenue.

Unfinished Business – There was no unfinished business.

New Business – There was no new business.

Adjournment – The meeting adjourned at 12:48 p.m.
