# New approach publication

Scheduled to be published 9/13/2018.

- Draft approach plates to add: → GPS RNAV LPV WAAS Approach to Runway 31 (vertically guided at 225 ft. ceiling and ¾ mile visibility); and
- GPS RNAV LP WAAS Approach to Runway 13 (non-vertically guided at 587 ft. ceiling and 1 mile visibility); and ÷
- An amendment to the Localizer approach to Runway 31; and
- Cancellation of the current GPS approach to Runway 31 are also included.
