Call to Order, Welcome, and Invocation

Chairman Purcell called the meeting to order and announced a quorum in attendance. He welcomed everyone and called for the invocation. The invocation was delivered by **Commissioner Hope**.

Mr Chris Eversmann introduced Mr Sparty Hammett, Assistant County Administrator

under whose oversight the Airport now falls. Chairman Purcell welcomed Mr Hammett and thanked him for attending.

Approval of Minutes

Chairman Purcell presented the minutes of the July 8, 2013 Airport Commission meeting for approval. **Chairman Purcell** made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, **Commissioner Hope** seconded, and all approved.

Approval of Agenda

Chairman Purcell presented the agenda as circulated. **Commissioner Hope** made a motion to approve the agenda as presented, **Commissioner Christopher** seconded, and all approved.

Report of Items for Executive Session

Commissioner Purcell made a motion to defer the executive session until the end of the agenda. **Commissioner Hope** second, all approved.

<u>Presentation</u> – Mr Scott Linaberry with CW Hanger Partners, LLC gave a Project Status Update brief on the Curtiss-Wright Hanger restoration and redevelopment project. He stated they were in the process of arranging for the sale of historic property restoration tax credits and asked that Commissioners refer any interested parties to him to find out more. Parties with a genuine interest in aviation history and live in South Carolina are preferred, but not required. Mr Linaberry said that it is important that the hanger maintain the Curtiss-Wright name along with whatever new additional names might be added. He explained the benefits and differences of the tax credit programs and noted that tax advisors have been retained. Project Architects and Engineers (A/E) have also been identified.

Roughly 35 aircraft arrived and departed during a recent game with the busiest hours were between 3:00 and 5:00 p.m. A good volume of fuel sales were generated as a result of the activity. <u>Operations Committee</u> – Commissioner Christopher reported that the owner of City Roots Urban Farm has expressed interest in using a small area of undeveloped airport property for their farming operation. That could mean no maintenance on our part in that area and it would generate a small amount of revenue. However, there are additional details to be discussed and worked out.

Airport Director's Report

Airport News – Mr Eversmann reported the pilot involved in the recent "gear up" emergency landing had undergone a similar landing several years ago, but was not injured. He also spoke on the outstanding service provided by first responders and officials at the scene. **Mr Eversmann** shared with the Commission an article in the August 30th edition of the *Columbia Star* regarding "National Aviation Week"
