#### **ITEMS FOR ACTION**

- 2. <u>Expiration of Contracts for Solid Waste Curbside Collection Service Areas 1, 3 & 4</u> The Committee forwarded this item to Council without a recommendation.
- 3. <u>Safe Routes to Schools Grants</u> The Committee recommended that Council approve the request for Richland County to support schools in their applications for grant funding to construct sidewalks to connect schools to neighborhoods under the South Carolina Department of Transportation's (SCDOT's) Safe Route to Schools Program. **CONSENT**
- 4. Approving Reimbursement Resolution related to preliminary expenditures related to the Lower Richland Sewer System Project Phase I The Committee recommended that Council approve the Reimbursement Resolution related to preliminary expenditures for the Lower Richland Sewer System Project, Phase I. The funds will be advanced from the Broad River Utility System. The Committee also recommended that "intent" be replaced with "will be" throughout the Resolution.
- 5. <u>Define the vehicles subject to Section 17-10, Parking in Residential and Commercial Zones of the County</u> This item was deferred to the April D&S Committee meeting. Staff is to work with applicable parties on a revised ordinance.
